Observation: Please read **Matthew 5:21-30**

Introduction: As Jesus continues to expound upon the law, He turns His discourse to the discussion of sin and reconciliation.

Questions for Consideration:

- Why does Jesus place such a heavy price on misplaced anger, and, what is the fall out from it? (vs. 22)
- How does our lack of reconciliation with another hinder our worship? (vs. 24)
- From David's example in 2 Samuel 11:2-27, what lessons can we learn from the dangers of lust and adultery? (vs. 27-29)

Personal Exploration:

- How can safeguards and accountability partners serve as instruments of grace?

Inspiration:

In your personal time, reflect upon the many ways that Jesus' love has been expressed through ways of escape that He has provided you from sin.
